Cake Bake Rules

- 1. This is a Cub Scout project. The fun is in baking and decorating, so let them take the lead on this. The idea is to make this a fun experience for your Scout.**
- 2. Just about any cake theme is welcome.**
- 3. No store-bought cakes! Cubs must bake and decorate the cake and must help clean up!**
- 4. Cake mixes, and canned frosting are fine; you don't need to bake from scratch.**
